

(Please read the following instructions carefully before applying)

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP/GRANTS

- 1) The Award of Scholarship/Grant is open to the Students
 - a) who have completed Standard XI/PUC II/First/Second/Third years (equivalent semesters) of Degree/Diploma course/First/Second year (equivalent Semesters) of Post Graduation in any of the following streams and are pursuing further studies of same/different stream from recognised School/college/institution (including IITs, deemed universities) Arts, Commerce, Science, Medicine, Engineering, Technology, IT, Management, Architecture, Law and any other recognised professional studies
 - b) who are not gainfully employed.
 - c) who have scored overall **more than 50% of marks or equivalent grade** in previous examination;
- 2) The Scholarships/grants are open to full time courses only.
- 3) Students whose family's total annual income is less than Rs. 1,00,000/- are alone eligible for Scholarship/grant.
- 4) Students may be selected for award of scholarship/grant on the basis of need also in exceptional cases.
- 5) Applications for Scholarships/grants will be invited by the Trustees of the Nidhi once a year by publishing in Bhavsar Jyoti magazine. The last date for receipt of applications will be **31st December** every year. In case of change of the date, the same will be notified through Bhavsar Jyoti. Applications received after the last date prescribed will not be considered and no communication from applicants and/or recommendations of affiliated Samaj Sanstha office bearers would be entertained.
- 7) Successful applicants will be informed of the award of Scholarship/grant individually and their names would be published in Bhavsar Jyoti.
- 8) The amount of scholarship/grant will be payable in one lumpsum by crossed 'A/c Payee' cheque OR by direct credit to account of the student or the person notified by him/her.
- 9) The decision of Trustees will be final in every respect.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

- 1) Application should be made in prescribed form only. The application forms are available in VUN Trust Office. The format is also available online on ABBK Mahasabha's website, **bhavsarkshatriya.org** In case additional copy/ies are required, the same could be printed.
- 2) The application must be completed in all respect in legible handwriting and no blanks should be left. In case, no information is desirable under particular head, words 'not applicable' should be written. Incomplete applications are liable to be rejected.
- 3) Care should be taken to give full postal address with nearby landmark and PIN code so as to avoid return of communication/cheque by postal authorities. In case scholarships/grant is desired through Direct Credit to Bank Account, correct name of bank, Account title, Account Number as printed on pass book/cheque book, MICR code and IFSC Code as appearing on cheque book should be given.
- 4) Only Xerox copies of mark sheets/other documents should be sent with applications. The Original documents should be produced for verification if called for.
